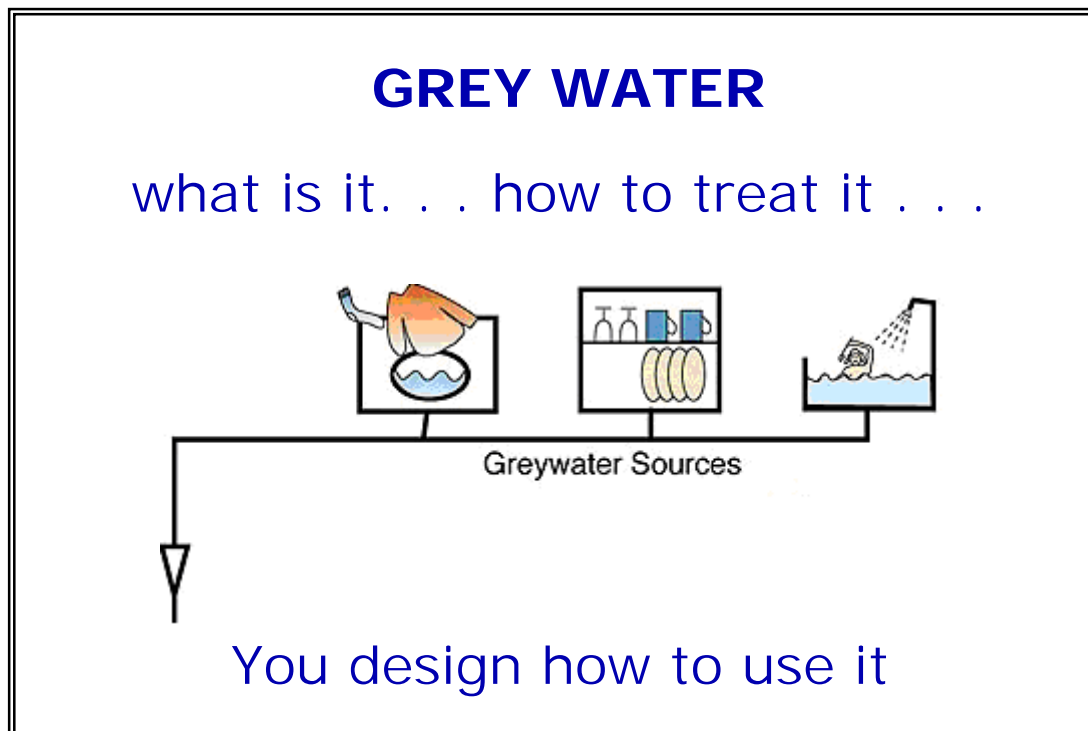




Re-use Grey Water Show Case Project
